TOLAY LAKE REGIONAL PARK INTERIM PLAN DAY-USE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pets must be leashed, under physical control and attended at all times. Maximum leash length is six (6) feet.
2. All dogs must have valid rabies vaccination certificates or valid licenses.
3. Horses must remain in designated areas.
4. Animals or plants of any kind may not be released in the parks.
5. All vehicles are subject to the California Vehicle Code. All drivers must be licensed.
6. Bicycles and vehicles must follow posted speed limits. Bicycle helmets are required for riders under 18 years of age.
7. Motorized vehicles and trailers must stay on roads and in designated parking areas. They are not allowed on paths and trails.
8. Fires are permitted in BBQ's only.
9. Gathering or cutting wood is illegal.
10. A gathering of 25 or more people, special events, classes or commercial activities require approval and a permit from Regional Parks, prior to the event.
11. Posting of signage, flyers, etc. is prohibited unless Regional Parks gives approval and written authorization.
12. Public nudity is prohibited.
13. Dumping of household trash is not allowed.
14. Model airplanes, boats and cars cannot be operated in any Regional Park.
15. Golfing is not allowed in the parks.
16. Shooting arrows, air or gas weapons, slingshots, rockets or fireworks is prohibited.
17. Hunting and possession of firearms are illegal.
18. Fishing, where permitted, is subject to California State Fish and Game regulations.
19. Do not remove, deface, or climb upon park structures or trees.
20. All plants, mushrooms, animals, shells and geologic features, living or dead are protected and may not be removed.
21. Feeding, disturbing or harassing the wildlife and/or farm animals is prohibited.
22. **PARKS AND GATES CLOSE AT POSTED TIMES.**
23. Stay on the trail at all times.
24. Do Not Touch or Disturb possible cultural artifacts. Contact Parks staff.
25. Visitors must possess a permit or accompany a permit holder at all times.
