Four years ago we were a founding member of the Landscape Water Advisory Group (LWAG) with the Sonoma County Water Agency and all major municipal water districts. There we helped develop the Qualified Water Efficient Landscaper (QWEL) training program. This training program came to fruition in 2007 and is open to all landscape professionals. It teaches in depth information on landscape water conservation and has graduated 77 landscape professionals to date. It currently is being taught at Santa Rosa Junior College and College of Marin. Sonoma County Water Agency emphasizes this type of training program will contribute significantly to the county meeting its future water needs.

Pacific Landscapes was on the City of Santa Rosa's committee to develop their model landscape water ordinance for single family residential development that became effective January 1, 2007. We also received their only commercial water conservation award from the city for the 2006 year.
