

RESOLUTION OF THE SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
ACKNOWLEDGING THE CONTRIBUTION OF THE CONSULATE GENERAL OF  
MEXICO – SAN FRANCISCO FOR ESTABLISHING A NO-COST BOOKS IN  
SPANISH PROGRAM IN SONOMA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of Mexico has an established the Books in Spanish program for children of Mexican origin in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of Mexico’s Books in Spanish program serves to strengthen the identity of children and young adults of Mexican origin or citizenship living in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of Mexico – San Francisco has reached out to Sonoma County and established a relationship with the county’s official anti-poverty agency – Community Action Partnership; and

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of Mexico – San Francisco has contributed over 11,000 text, young adult and children’s fiction books to families in Sonoma County through its partner Community Action Partnership; and

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of Mexico – San Francisco has positively influenced the overall ideal of a more literate Sonoma County through the contribution free Spanish language books; and
