Resolution approving the County Plan for the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 (SACPA) between the County of Sonoma and the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs, State of California, for FY 09-10, and authorizing the Director of Health Services to implement the plan and any modifications to the plan that do not significantly change program content, within approved budget authority.

WHEREAS, the Department of Health Services is the lead agency responsible for implementation and provision of alcohol and other drug services as mandated by the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 (SACPA); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.5, Title 9, California Code of Regulations requires submission of an approved plan outlining how the County will provide and fund services to SACPA clients; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1808 established the Substance Abuse Offender Treatment (OTP) to serve offenders who qualify for services under SACPA; and

WHEREAS, the goal of OTP is to improve SACPA program outcomes and provide financial incentives for counties to invest local funds to develop improved accountability for difficult offenders; and

WHEREAS, the FY 09-10 Proposed Budget includes a General Fund matching contribution which meets the State's requirement for distribution of OTP funding.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma hereby approves the FY 09-10 County Plan for the implementation of the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000, completed pursuant to Chapter 2.5, Title 9, California Code of Regulations, by the Department of Health Services, Alcohol and Other Drug Services Division; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors directs that the Department comply with the provisions of the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 and the California Code of Regulations, Division 4, Chapter 2.5; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors has established a special revenue fund for SACPA funding and shall deposit all SACPA funding received from the State of California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs into said fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors has established a special revenue fund for OTP funding and shall deposit all OTP funding received from the State of California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs into said fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma hereby delegates approval authority for plan modifications within the allocation, to the Department of Health Services, Alcohol and Other Drug Services Division.
