Alternatives - Results of Non-Approval: Leave these intersections uncontrolled as to right-of-way. Choose alternate stops.

Background:

Department staff received a request from a Deputy Sheriff who had met with local residents to review the need for a stop sign at the intersection of Deerwood Drive and Sussex Drive in Larkfield. Currently this intersection has no stop signs controlling its traffic.

An investigation showed that eastbound motorists on Deerwood Drive have limited sight distance to the right at the intersection with Sussex Drive. Stopping motorists eastbound on Deerwood Drive provides sufficient viewing time in order to see vehicles approaching from the right on Sussex Drive.

The investigation also showed that southbound motorists on Hatona Drive have limited sight distance to the left at the intersection with Lambert Drive. Currently this intersection has no stop signs controlling its traffic. Stopping motorists southbound on Hatona Drive provides sufficient viewing time in order to see vehicles approaching from the left on Lambert Drive.

The investigation also showed that westbound motorists on Lambert Drive have limited sight distance to the left at the intersection with St James Drive. Currently this intersection has no stop signs controlling its traffic. Stopping motorists westbound on Lambert Drive provides sufficient viewing time in order to see vehicles approaching from the left on St James Drive.

The estimated cost of installing the required signs and pavement markings for these three intersections is \$1,500.00.

Recommendation:

Approve Resolution that directs stopping Deerwood Drive at Sussex Drive, stopping Hatona Drive at Lambert Drive, and stopping Lambert Drive at St James Drive. (Fourth Supervisorial District).
