**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF SONOMA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF PROBATION
OFFICER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT
OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION (CDCR) FOR DIAGNOSTIC AND
TREATMENT SERVICES FOR JUVENILES**

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge within a County has the authority to refer eligible juveniles to the custody of the State of California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) for diagnostic and treatment services, as well as temporary detention, if the Court determines that Sonoma County facilities for such services are insufficient; and

WHEREAS, the Sonoma County Probation Department is responsible for executing the orders of the Court, and transferring the referred juvenile to CDCR custody for the provision of such services; and

WHEREAS, the Welfare and Institutions Code Section 1752.1 requires that the CDCR enter into a contract with counties to allow for the provision of such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Chief Probation Officer Robert M. Ochs is authorized on behalf of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors to execute a contract with the State of California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) regarding the provision and payment of diagnostic and treatment services, as well as temporary detention, for juveniles referred to the CDCR by the Juvenile or Criminal Court under California Welfare and Institutions Code §1752.1, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for the term to begin retroactively on July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2010.
