RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 93-1309 DATED AUGUST 31, 1993, TO REVISE: 1) THE SCHEDULE OF PARKING FINES AND PENALTIES, AND 2) THE REVENUE SPLITTING FORMULA FOR PARKING FINE COLLECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to established a schedule of parking fines for parking violations pursuant to California Vehicle Code section 40203.5; and

WHEREAS, County Code Section 18-1 provides that the Board of Supervisors shall establish a schedule of parking penalties by resolution; and

WHEREAS, on August 31, 1993, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 93-1309, establishing, *inter alia*, a schedule of parking fines and a revenue splitting formula for parking fine collections; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 70372(b) now requires the County to remit to the State \$4.50 for every parking citation issued in order to fund the State Court Facilities Construction Fund; and

WHEREAS, parking penalties have not been adjusted since 1993 and, due to inflation and State surcharge increases, the Sonoma County Parking Program is operating at a net cost deficit; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with California Vehicle Code section 40203.5(a), staff recommends the Board of Supervisors adopt a fine schedule that is commensurate with fine schedules adopted by other agencies within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend the County's fine schedule in order to adjust for increased State surcharges and to meet the present-day operating costs of the Parking Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. All of the above recitals are true and correct;

2. This Board does hereby amend Resolution No. 93-1309, dated August 31, 1993, by replacing Attachment 1 thereto (Parking Fines for Issuing Authorities and Schedule of Violations and Fines) with the Schedule of Parking Fines and Penalties for the County of Sonoma, attached hereto as Exhibit A;

3. This Board hereby approves the following revenue splitting formula from parking fines issued and collected by the County of Sonoma to support the County's Parking Program:

Auditor-Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector	25%
Department of General Services	75%
