LOCAL ASSISTANCE FUNDS - FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Tuberculosis Control Branch (TBCB) anticipates having approximately \$9.5 million available for tuberculosis (TB) control local assistance subvention funds in fiscal year (FY) 2009-2010 (July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2010). FY 2009-2010 is the second year of a two-year funding cycle. Funding is subject to the availability of federal and State funds, a signed State budget, and is dependent on program priorities.

The Base Award allocated to Sonoma County Department of Health Services to support TB control activities in your jurisdiction for FY 2009-2010 is contained in the table below:

The anticipated FY 2009-2010 Food, Shelter, Incentives and Enablers (FSIE) Allotment for the Sonoma County Department of Health Services is \$4,899.
