01/13/09 Resolution No. 09-0026 authorizing the General Manager/Chief Engineer to sign and file, for and on behalf of the District, a financial assistance application to the State Water Resources Control Board for State Revolving Fund Loan funding for the Treatment Plant Disinfection Upgrade Project, and take all actions necessary to secure such funding

**Alternatives - Results of Non-Approval:**  
Low-interest loan financing would not be available to the Russian River CSD Disinfection Upgrade Project.

**Background:**

The Russian River County Sanitation District (District) Disinfection Upgrade Project (Project) consists of the design and construction of an ultraviolet light (UV) disinfection system and facility upgrades to improve the influent water quality of the UV disinfection system.

On January 13, 2009, the Board of Directors of the District authorized the General Manager/Chief Engineer to finance the costs of planning, designing, and constructing the Project with a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB).

The District will incur costs for planning and designing the Project prior to executing a loan contract. Upon signing a loan contract, the District intends to reimburse some of these costs with loan funds. Since the SWRCB funds its SRF program by selling tax-exempt bonds, it requires the District to adopt a Resolution stating such intent, and confirming that the expenses that are reimbursed from loan funds are those, which qualify as capital expenses under federal tax principles. The Resolution is necessary to provide the SWRCB and investors who purchase the tax-exempt bonds that fund the SRF program with assurance that the District's use of the funds will not jeopardize the bonds' tax-exempt status. The expenses for which reimbursement will be sought have been identified as qualifying expenses in the SRF program policy. Under the terms of the Resolution, which is based on a model provided by the state, reimbursement will be limited to those expenses incurred within sixty (60) days before the Resolution is adopted.
