Dear Chairman Mackenzie:

The Sonoma County Water Agency has received your resolution requesting that the Agency increase water deliveries during peak demand periods. Ordinarily, these periods occur during heat spells, which often last only a few days, when outdoor irrigation increases. Fortunately, there are a number of strategies available to retail water suppliers to mitigate these high demand events. The Agency will send out additional water conservation messages to encourage water users in our service area to limit outdoor watering during peak demand periods.

The Agency will continue to closely monitor both current storage levels and anticipated water demand trends as part of its efforts to maintain adequate storage during a prolonged heat wave that typically results in increased outdoor irrigation. In the unlikely event that storage levels decrease to levels that represent a concern for public health, the Agency would identify and implement the most feasible methods for increasing storage in the water transmission system.
