

Background: Department of Transportation and Public Works staff received a request from a local restaurant owner (Frank Gonnella, owner of The Union Hotel) to place a parking zone for persons with disabilities on Minna Street adjacent to the restaurant east of the intersection with Main Street.

It is recommended that the parking zone for persons with disabilities be established as requested on the northerly side of Minna Street beginning at Post Mile 10.015, and extending in a westerly direction for 25 feet (see attached location map).

The property owner who made this request is the only one affected directly by the establishment of the restricted zone.

The cost of pavement markings and required signing, including installation, will be the responsibility of the restaurant owner at no cost to the County. Of course, any future maintenance of the installation will fall to the County to do at public expense.

Recommendation:

Approve an ordinance establishing a parking zone for persons with disabilities on Minna Street (Fifth Supervisorial District).
