RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THE COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
APPROVING A COOPERATIVE FUNDING AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE SONOMA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION
AUTHORITY AND THE COUNTY OF SONOMA FOR THE
SONOMA-SHELLVILLE TRAIL PROJECT

WHEREAS, voters of Sonoma County passed the Traffic Relief Act for Sonoma County – Measure M Expenditure Plan; and; and

WHEREAS, the Class 1 path connecting Highway 121 to the city of Sonoma, known as the Sonoma-Schellville Trail Project, was identified as a Bicycle/Pedestrian project to connect to the San Francisco Bay Trail; and

WHEREAS, the County of Sonoma (County) seeks funding from the Sonoma County Transportation Authority (Authority) for the purpose of implementing the Sonoma-Schellville Trail Project; and

WHEREAS, the completed trail project is estimated to cost in excess of \$1.8 million; and

WHEREAS Measure M includes \$650,000 for purpose of implementing the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute Cooperative Funding Agreement No. M70410 with the Authority.
