

Background:

The 92,343 seniors, age 60 and older, represent 19% of Sonoma County’s total population, higher than both the state (16%) and national (17%) average of people over 60 years old.

The FY 2008-09 Annual Report highlights specific AAA accomplishments and summarizes services provided to seniors in Sonoma County during the last fiscal year. Some of those services were provided directly through AAA and others were provided through contracted service providers. This report was approved by the AAA Advisory Council on September 16, 2009. It is being brought to the Board of Supervisors for final approval prior to its submission to the California Department of Aging.

The “Year-End Report Transmittal Letter” and information required by the California Department of Aging, which includes “Impact of Activities and “Goals and Objectives” specifying results, are on file with the clerk. The categories of activities are:

- Access to Transportation
- Awareness of Services
- Access to Home and Community-Based Services
- Partnerships

Following approval by the Board of Supervisors, the report will also be distributed to local legislators, senior service providers, and interested organizations and individuals.
