On November 5, 2009, the Sonoma County Community Development Commission will hold a Technical Assistance Session for agencies/organizations interested in applying for fiscal year 2010-2011 funding from the following sources:

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)  
HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME)  
Emergency Shelter Grants (ESG)

The session will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Community Development Commission office, 1440 Guerneville Road, Santa Rosa. All applicants should attend this Technical Assistance Session. Any applicant who cannot attend the scheduled Session should contact the Commission staff as soon as possible.

All proposals (**including** proposals initiated by the incorporated jurisdictions) must be submitted to the Community Development Commission by 5 p.m. on January 8, 2010. *NOTE: For projects located within one of the incorporated areas of Cloverdale, Cotati, Healdsburg, Rohnert Park, Sebastopol, Sonoma and Windsor, applications must be reviewed and endorsed by the appropriate city/town council before submission. Therefore, a SCCDC-provided Letter of Intent form summarizing the details of the project must be sent to SCCDC, which will then forward it to the city or town where the project will be located, not later than December 1, 2009 in order to allow sufficient time for City/Town Council action.* Eligible proposals will be considered for funding at one of two public hearings, on March 8 and March 9, 2010. At the conclusion of the hearings, funding recommendations will be forwarded to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors. The Board will make final funding decisions on May 4, 2010.
