CONSOLIDATED PLAN APPLICATION PROCESS

The HUD Consolidated Plan application for FY 2008-2009 includes applications for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, HOME Investment Partnerships Act (HOME) Program, and Federal Emergency Shelter Grant (FESG) Program as part of the FY 2008-2009 Action Plan.

August 20, 2007 9:00 a.m.	Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) reviews proposed revisions to CDBG, HOME and FESG Policies.
September 11, 2007 3:30 p.m.	Community Development Committee (CDC) reviews proposed revisions to CDBG, HOME and FESG Policies.
October 9, 2007 3:30 p.m.	TAC/CDC Joint Public Hearing to identify housing and community development needs, review past program performance, and review CDBG, HOME and FESG Policies.
November 6, 2007 8:30 a.m.	Board of Supervisors adopts 2008/2009 CDBG, HOME and FESG Policies and authorizes County departments to prepare funding proposals.
November 8, 2007 9:00 a.m.	Technical Assistance Session for agencies/organizations interested in submitting proposals for inclusion in the 2008-2009 Action Plan. Notice of CDBG, HOME and FESG funding availability issued inviting submission of proposals for inclusion in FY 2008-2009 Action Plan.
November 9, 2007 – January 18, 2008	CDBG projects that are located in, and will serve the residents of, one or more specific incorporated areas (non-countywide projects) obtain the endorsement of the City/Town Council(s) of the jurisdiction(s) in which they will operate prior to submitting proposals to Commission. A Letter of Intent summarizing the details of the project must be sent to the CDC by December 3, 2007, which will then forward it to the city or town where the project will be located not later than December 6, 2007 in order to allow sufficient time for council action.
December 3, 2007	Deadline for Commission to receive Letter of Intent for any project to be located in an incorporated jurisdiction (except project of a county-wide nature.).
January 18, 2008 up to 5:00 p.m.	CDBG, HOME & FESG Proposals are due at Commission office. All proposals are submitted to Commission.

March 11, 2008 8:30 a.m.	Community Development Committee Public Hearing on all HOME and FESG proposals and CDBG proposals except for non-Public Services projects located in the incorporated jurisdictions. Make funding recommendations for proposals to be included in FY 2008-2009 Action Plan.
March 17, 2008 9:00 a.m.	TAC Public Hearing on CDBG non-Public Service proposals for projects in the incorporated jurisdictions. Make funding recommendations for proposals to be included in FY 2008-2009 Action Plan.
March 28, 2008	Publish and disseminate summary of FY 2008-2009 Action Plan. 30-day comment period begins.
April 28, 2008 5:00 p.m.	30-day public comment period ends. Written comments due at Commission office.
May 6, 2008 8:30 a.m.	Board of Supervisors public meeting to discuss and adopt FY 2008-2009 Action Plan.
May 15, 2008	Deadline for FY 2008-2009 Action Plan to be received at HUD office.
June 1 - July 30, 2008	Preparation and execution of FY 2008-2009 Subrecipient Agreements.
July 1, 2008	Beginning of 2008-2009 fiscal year (July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009).
