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# MCI PLAN DEACTIVATION

## Introduction

The third phase of the MCI Plan is deactivation, which always follows declared Plan activation. The purpose of a formal deactivation process is to keep MCI participants apprised that the attendant tasks associated with an MCI have been completed. Upon deactivation, normal day to day operations may resume.

## Definition

The termination of the response generated by the activation of the Plan. A verified indication that Coastal Valleys EMS Region medical units are returning to normal operations

## Deactivation Authority

The following have the authority to deactivate the MCI Plan:

- Incident Commander of the MCI
- EMS Dispatcher or Supervisor/designee acting upon the direction of the Incident Commander

## Deactivation Procedures

The Incident Commander of the MCI will contact EMS Dispatch directly or have jurisdictional PSAP relay to EMS Dispatch termination of the MCI. EMS Dispatch will notify the following of the MCI deactivation:

- Affected ambulance provider(s)
  - Moved-up or posted ambulances, as necessary
  - Jurisdictional fire/law agencies, as necessary
- Jurisdictional Base Hospital if necessary

EMS Dispatch Center Supervisor or designee will complete MCI checklist and fax or email a copy to the EMS Agency.

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
