## MEDICAL GROUP DIVISION SUPERVISOR

<b>Function</b>	Establish command and control the activities within a Medical Group, in order to assure the best possible emergency medical care to patients during a multi-casualty incident.
<b>Report To</b>	<b>Multi-Casualty Branch Director</b> , radio designation " <b>Multi-Casualty Branch</b> "
<b>Radio Designator</b>	Your radio designator is "Medical"
<b>Subordinates</b>	Triage, Treatment Unit Leaders, Medical Supply Coordinator
<b>Duties &amp; Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Obtain briefing from Multi-Casualty Branch Director or Operations Section Chief</li><li>▪ Participate in Section planning activities</li><li>▪ Establish Medical Group with assigned personnel; request additional personnel and resources sufficient to handle to magnitude of the incident (medical caches, ambulances, helicopter and other methods of patient transportation)</li><li>▪ Designate Unit Leaders and Treatment Area locations as appropriate</li><li>▪ Isolate Morgue and Minor Treatment Areas from immediate and Delayed Areas</li><li>▪ Request law enforcement/coroner involvement as needed</li><li>▪ Establish communications and coordination with Patient Transportation Group Supervisor</li><li>▪ Direct and/or supervise on-scene personnel from agencies such as Coroner's office, Red Cross, law enforcement, ambulance companies, county health agencies and health care volunteers</li><li>▪ Ensure proper security, traffic control and access for the Group area</li><li>▪ Direct medically trained personnel to the appropriate Unit Leader</li><li>▪ Maintain Unit Log (ICS 214)</li></ul>
