TRIAGE UNIT LEADER

Function	Manage triage activities; develop organization to handle triage; direct movement from area; provide guidance to triage personnel; establish safe triage area. When triage is complete, anticipate reassignment.
Report To	Medical Group Supervisor , radio designation " Medical "
Radio Designator	Your radio designator is " Triage Leader "
Subordinates	Triage personnel, Litter bearers, Morgue Manager
Duties & Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Obtain briefing from Medical Group Supervisor▪ Assess needs, develop strategy and organization sufficient to handle assignment▪ Request needed resources from Medical Group Supervisor▪ Develop sectors and assign triage teams accordingly▪ Supervise/manage triage activities▪ Maintain a safe triage area▪ Coordinate movement of patients from Triage Area to appropriate Treatment Transport Areas▪ Provide Medical Group Supervisor with periodic status reports▪ Establish Morgue area▪ Maintain security and control of Triage Area▪ Maintain Unit Log (ICS 214)
