HAZARDS GROUP SUPERVISOR

Function	Identify and mitigate immediate hazards to victims and rescuers that are not of a "Hazardous Materials" nature.
Report To	Rescue Branch Director, radio designation "Rescue"
Radio Designator	Your radio designator is "Hazards"
Subordinates	Hazard Control Teams
Duties & Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Obtain a briefing from the Rescue Branch Director.▪ Make an assessment of the scene and determine control needs.▪ If HAZARDOUS MATERIALS are involved, response should be in accordance with the Sonoma County Hazardous Materials Incident Response Plan.▪ Determine hazard control objectives and resource needs and request from the Rescue Group Supervisor.▪ Control hazards.▪ Coordinate with Extrication Group Supervisor.▪ Coordinate with Litter Group Supervisor.▪ Upon completion of hazard control objectives, report to Rescue Branch Director for reassignment.
