## SECURITY GROUP SUPERVISOR

<b>Function</b>	Provide incident security and law enforcement presence for the safety and security for both the involved public and the incident staff
<b>Report To</b>	<b>Law Branch Director</b> , radio designation " <b>Law</b> "
<b>Radio Designator</b>	Your radio designator is " <b>Security</b> "
<b>Subordinates</b>	Area Security Teams
<b>Duties &amp; Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Obtain a briefing from the Rescue Branch Director</li><li>▪ Make an assessment of the scene and determine security needs</li><li>▪ Establish perimeters as needed:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>at command post</li><li>at inner operational areas (helispot, morgue, etc.)</li><li>at outer incident area</li></ul></li><li>▪ Initiate an entry system into the incident<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>no access or limited access protocol</li></ul></li><li>▪ Coordinate and assist with Movement Group Supervisor<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Provide security to evacuated areas</li><li>Provide security at public collection facilities</li></ul></li><li>▪ Coordinate and assist with Investigation Group Supervisor<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Provide area of origin, crime scene and evidence security</li></ul></li><li>▪ Respond to and take appropriate action when requests for immediate intervention due to violent behavior, criminal action or breaches in security are reported</li></ul>
