INFORMATION BULLETIN - Fees For Service

Fire Plan Check and Inspection Fees:

Plan Review:

Required, all plan reviews shall receive a minimum 2 hour fee.

Not Required, plans after review shall receive a minimum 1 hour fee

Inspections:

Inspections are based on the number of inspection need to final a project

Residential

Building, the typical residential project requires a minimum of two 2 fire inspections, One (1) at foundation and one (1) at final. The minimum fee will be four (4) hours at the hourly rate.

Fire Sprinklers, will be two (2) additional inspections, One (1) for a close-in and one (1) at Final. The minimum fee will be four (4) hours at the hourly rate.

If the project has multiple buildings additional fees may be added, with the assumption not all buildings will be inspected at the same time based on the size of the project. The fire inspector is responsible for tracking the Fees for Service.

Commercial

Inspections are based on the number of inspection need to final a project for a possible estimate contact the commercial fire plan check at 707-565-1152
