**When you bring your dog to Regional Parks...**

- Keep your dog on a leash not more than 6 feet in length at all times, and under immediate physical control. Your dog may be off leash only if it is within a designated dog off leash area. A dog is also considered leashed if it is securely tied to a stationary object, and under immediate control/supervision.
- No dogs, cats, or other animals may be turned loose at any time within a Sonoma County Regional Park.
- While staying at Sonoma County Regional Parks campgrounds, pets must be kept inside a vehicle or tent throughout the night.
- All dogs must have a valid license or current rabies inoculation.
- Dogs cannot be left unattended.
- Vicious or unusually noisy dogs will not be allowed to enter or remain in park areas.
- No dogs are allowed in restrooms or showers.
- Sonoma County Code 5-125(a) requires you to clean up after your dog.

**Violation of the above rules may subject you to citation, court appearance, and a fine under Sonoma County Code Section 20-8. THANK YOU FOR OBSERVING THE LEASH LAW. WE APPRECIATE YOUR CONSIDERATION FOR OTHER PEOPLE, THEIR PETS, AND PARK WILDLIFE.**
