



Field Trip Information

About the Field Trip

The Sonoma County Regional Parks Department provides a 3-hour program for students in grades K - 6 on Monday - Friday mornings. Students will rotate through stations that focus on science in outdoor lessons that complement our resource preservation themes and reinforce California State Science, Math and Language Arts standards.

Group Size

Our program has been developed with maximum student learning in mind. We will accept no more than three classrooms (of same grade level) per field trip visit. (60 students maximum)

Chaperones

Please make sure that there is one adult for every ten students. We plan on these adults to help manage the field trips to ensure fun, learning, and safety.

Reservations and Program Fee

Cost: \$5.00 per student admission fee. Included in the fee:

- Parking for bus and parent chaperone vehicles
- 3 hour staff-led session
- Journal for each student

Please be prepared to pay all fees on the day of the field trip.

A minimum of three weeks advance notice is requested for a reservation. Prior to your field trip you will be directed to download the Teacher Packet which includes the field trip schedule, maps to the parks, the content information for each field trip, and parking passes.

Confirmation

Once your school is scheduled we will e-mail you confirmation information. Upon receiving your e-mail confirmation, we ask that you e-mail reply to confirm that the dates and times are acceptable. We will notify by e-mail, any groups that we cannot schedule and place them on the waiting list. The contact person will be notified if a time slot becomes available. Cancellation

Instructors will receive a full refund if field trip is cancelled at least three weeks prior the trip date. Instructors cancelling a field trip less than three weeks before the trip date will receive a 75% refund.
