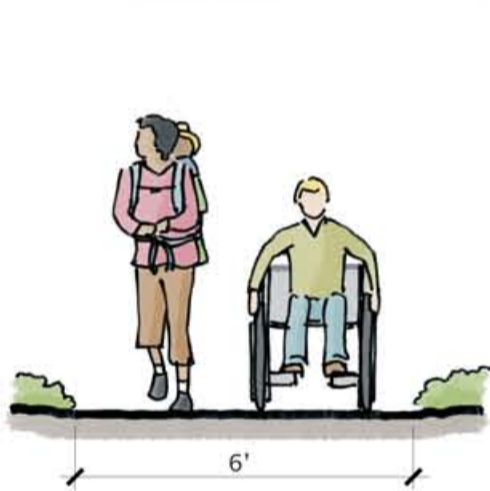


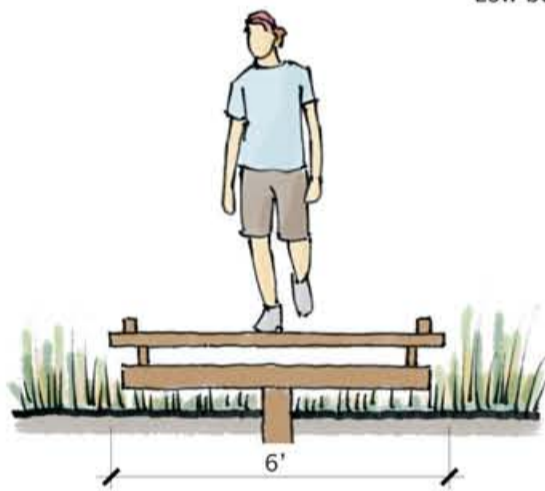


Low boardwalk with interpretive stations is one component of the educational trail



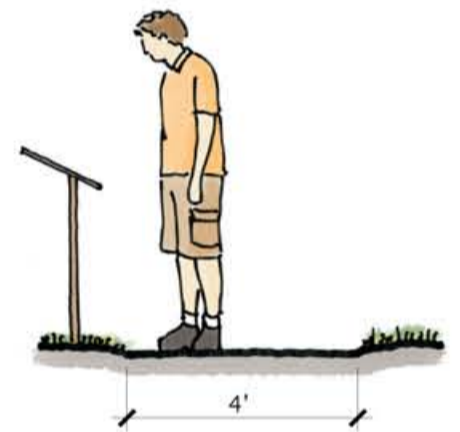
ACCESSIBLE TRAIL

Firm and stable surface (may be paved).
Relatively flat (5% slope).
Connects to designated trailhead(s).
Pedestrian only.



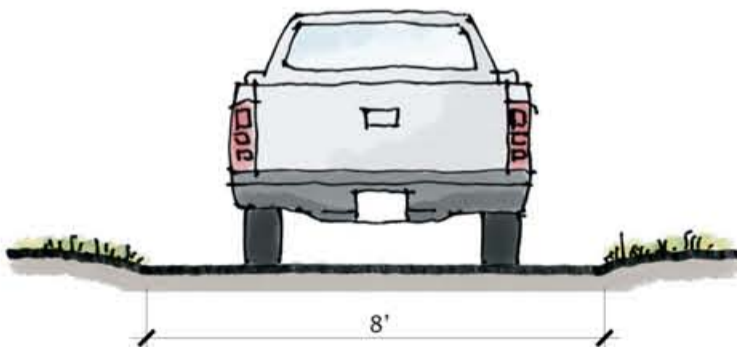
BOARDWALK

Used to traverse through sensitive, boggy habitat.
Single post design minimizes impacts.
Pedestrian only.



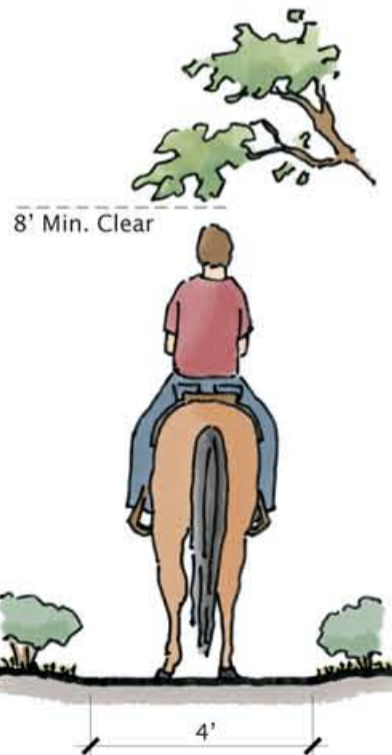
EDUCATIONAL TRAIL

Includes interpretive/educational stations.
Pedestrian only.
Otherwise, same as multi-use trail.



MAINTENANCE ROAD

Firm and stable surface (such as gravel).
Emergency, maintenance, and authorized vehicles only.
Pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians OK.



MULTI-USE TRAIL

Pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians OK.
Trail steepness and difficulty can vary.
Construction usually native soil.



SINGLE-TRACK

Pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians OK.
Sometimes one-way for safety.
Often through challenging terrain.
Construction usually native soil.
