

Appendix A. Sonoma County Hazard Mitigation Planning Process

Organization of the Planning Effort

The Permit & Resource Management Department is the lead agency responsible for the Sonoma County Hazard Mitigation Plan (SCHMP).¹ Financial support for the planning effort was received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency through the highly competitive Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Program in April, 2004. To supplement staff resources and secure the services of subject matter experts, the County contracted with a consultant team, led by Natural Hazards Mitigation, to provide assistance in plan development.²

Sonoma County convened an Oversight Committee to provide day to day oversight and management of the planning effort.³ The Oversight Committee met on a quarterly basis and provided guidance and support as needed throughout the planning process. The Committee was also charged with reviewing all draft documents and providing suggested revisions to the consultant team.

Additionally, a Technical Team, made up of representatives from key County departments was appointed to provide input and information resources to the consultant team and to review draft documents. The Technical Team was a critical resource in developing mitigation priorities, and implementation strategies. The Team met at two critical points, first at project initiation, and again to review the Administrative Draft of the plan. Team members were available throughout the planning effort on an as needed basis to respond to questions or review draft documents. A full roster of the Technical Team is included in later in this Appendix.

Planning Process Steps

Sonoma County followed its standard plan development process in all phases of plan preparation which is consistent with the four-step hazard mitigation planning process recommended by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in its State and Local Hazard Mitigation Planning “How to Guides”.

1. **Organize Resources:** At the outset of the project, the Oversight Committee and consultant team identified potential stakeholders, technical resources, and existing state-of-the art information sources to support the planning effort. This included appointing and convening the Technical Team (described above), developing mailing lists and notifying public stakeholders, convening an Agency Stakeholders Meeting and a Public Input Workshop, and collecting all available hazard information from internal County and external agency sources.

Additionally, the County identified the Sonoma County Operational Area Emergency Council and the Sonoma County Operational Area Coordinators as the most effective mechanism for SCHMP input and review from Sonoma County cities and adjacent counties, private-non profit organizations, academic institutions, utility providers and the private sector.

2. Assess Risks: The County reviewed the list of potential hazards that could pose a threat to people and property and have the potential for economic impacts. The Oversight Committee determined that the hazard mitigation plan should focus on four key hazards in the County: earthquake, landslide, flood and wildland fire, due to their frequency of occurrence and potential for causing significant physical and economic damage. A review of all possible hazards is included in Appendix B of this Plan. A starting point in developing the hazard identification and analysis section of the SCHMP was a thorough review of the existing policies contained in the County Public Safety Element of the General Plan, and the results of staff reports and public workshops conducted in the current update of the General Plan 2020. This information was supplemented by the most recent studies and data produced by federal, state and local agencies, including, but not limited to: the United States Geological Survey, United States Army Corp of Engineers, United States Forest Service, Federal Emergency Management Agency, California Office of Emergency Services, California Seismic Safety Commission, California Geological Survey, Department of Water Resources, the California Division of Forestry and Fire Protection, and the Association of Bay Area Governments. A description of each hazard was developed, including event characteristics, event history, and the potential for future occurrence. Exposure and vulnerability of county assets was then conducted and impact and loss estimates were developed. A description of the hazard assessment methodology is included in Appendix D of the Plan.
3. Mitigation Planning: Based on the hazard identification and analysis conducted in the previous step, and an assessment of current County mitigation capabilities (staff, codes and standards, current programs, and development trends), the County identified mitigation goals and objectives and a wide range of potential mitigation strategies and actions to mitigate the effects of future earthquake, landslide, flood and wildfire events. Following an in-depth review by the Oversight Committee, Technical Team and other interested stakeholders, the list of mitigations was refined based on an assessment of the social, technical, administrative, political, legal, economic, and environmental factors that either could contribute to or impede successful implementation. The resulting list of mitigation actions was then prioritized, again drawing on the expertise of the Oversight Committee and Technical Team, and included in the SCHMP.
4. Implementation of Plan and Monitoring Process: An Implementation Plan was developed, with input from the Oversight Committee, Technical Team and other interested stakeholders for the highest priority mitigation strategies developed in the previous step. Following adoption of the SCHMP, the County will follow the procedures outlined within the plan to periodically review and update the plan as necessary.

Public Participation Process in Sonoma County

Sonoma County follows a fully open, publicly accessible process for all plan development. All stakeholders in the County's planning process are provided with early notification of planning, and are kept fully informed and educated as to the issues involved in the planning process. As a result the county is able to identify and resolve issues early in the planning effort. Development of the Sonoma County Hazard Mitigation Plan followed the same public participation philosophy and process.

Sonoma County is strongly committed to public participation in the SCHMP planning process. The County established several goals to guide its public outreach and participation efforts for the SCHMP as follows:

1. Use multiple modes of communication to let the general public know that the County is seeking public input on the SCHMP and let them know how they may follow or contribute to the plan preparation.
2. Provide multiple methods and multiple opportunities for public input and/or review.
3. Conduct specific outreach to, and elicit input from key stakeholders, including citizens who may be affected by disasters, first responders, public utility and service providers, media, schools and universities, adjacent jurisdictions, business and industry groups, chamber of commerce, planning and economic development agencies and commissions, water management districts and river basin commissions, historic preservation organizations, federal and state agencies, professional organizations and local community groups and non-profit organizations.
4. Provide ongoing outreach to increase public awareness of hazards and educate the public regarding measures they should take to minimize and/or avoid disaster damages.

The planning process for the SCHMP used a number of techniques to attract public involvement in the program. These include:

1. Direct contact by county staff with key interest groups that have been involved in past disaster response and recovery planning efforts.
2. The use of media (newspapers, internet, TV, radio).
3. The use of a mailing list and formal public noticing techniques such as are used in similar county projects.
4. Creation of a webpage on the County website to provide access to all public documents produced during the course of the planning process.
5. Public workshops and hearings

Although the SCHMP development process is a separate planning effort from the General Plan 2020 (GP2020) Update process, the GP2020 update process for the Public Safety Element was a starting point for developing the SCHMP. Information gathered at a series of six public meetings held in 2001 throughout the County to elicit public comments and concerns regarding land use issues and public safety issues related to flooding, geologic (seismic and landslide) and fire hazards were timely and relevant to development of the SCHMP. These meetings were attended by approximately 900 citizens and provided valuable input regarding public concern and suggestions for improving disaster resistance in their communities. The parallel planning processes allow for consistency in mitigation policy and implementation.

Concurrent with the County review of the SCHMP Mitigation Strategies and Implementation Plan in the spring of 2006, the public review process for the GP2020 Public Safety Element Update was initiated. The input and comments presented at these public hearings has been taken into account in finalizing the SCHMP Mitigation Strategies and Implementation Plan.

Public Outreach Activities

In addition to the above public meetings, outreach to the broader general public was achieved at the outset of the project, using newspaper, radio and television and internet to disseminate information about the SCHMP planning process as described below:

1. Press releases were sent to twenty-one local papers newspapers, ten radio stations, and two television stations, including Spanish language newspaper and radio stations, announcing the commencement of the SCHMP planning process, discussing the need for and purpose of the plan, and providing the public contacts for following and/or participating in the process.
2. Two one-hour interview shows on were televised on TV Channel 50, a local public affairs television station discussing disaster history in Sonoma County, the SCHMP, local grant programs, and preparedness measures.
3. A SCHMP interactive link was established on the PRMD website which provided meeting schedules and draft documents available for review and comment.
4. Identification and outreach to key stakeholders and interested groups was carried out through mailings to a 485 name direct mailing list including citizens who may be affected by disasters, first responders, public utility and service providers, media, schools and universities, adjacent jurisdictions, business and industry groups, chambers of commerce, planning and economic development agencies and commissions, water management districts and river basin commissions, historic preservation organizations, federal and state agencies, professional organizations and local community groups and non-profit organizations.
5. The list was used to provide notice and invitation to public workshops at project initiation and during the public review and input process prior to adoption of the SCHMP.
6. Follow up meetings and discussions were held as needed throughout the plan development process with key stakeholders with an interest in specific hazards or mitigation issues.

Plan Review and Adoption

The Public Review Draft of the SCHMP, dated May 26, 2006 was released for review and comment by agencies, departments, stakeholders and the general public. The following steps were taken to ensure all interested parties had an opportunity to review and comment on the draft plan.

1. A public notice was issued announcing the availability of the plan and announcing a public workshop where the draft plan would be presented.
2. The Public Review Draft was posted on the PRMD website, where it could be downloaded and comments could be submitted.
3. Copies of the plan were available for review at the PRMD offices and at the following public libraries: Central Santa Rosa, Cloverdale, Guerneville, Healdsburg, Petaluma, Rohnert Park - Cotati, Sebastopol, Sonoma, and Windsor.
4. Presentations were made to the Sonoma County Operational Area Disaster Council and the Sonoma County Operational Area Emergency Coordinators Forum.
5. A Public/Agency Workshop was held on June 29, 2006 to present the plan and respond to comments and questions.
6. A Public Meeting of the Environmental Review Committee was held on August 15, 2006 to review the Draft Initial Study and Negative Declaration prepared for the SCHMP.
7. A Board of Supervisors Hearing was held on September 19, 2006. The draft plan was presented and a final opportunity was provided for public comment. Following the closing of the Public Hearing, the Board of Supervisors took action to adopt the SCHMP and the Negative Declaration.
