Sealed bids will be received at the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Room 100A, 575 Administration Drive, Santa Rosa, California 95403 on June 15, 2011, until the hour of 3:00 p.m. (according to the wall clock in the reception area of the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors). They then will be transferred to a predetermined meeting room designated by the Sonoma County Department of Transportation and Public Works where they will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Sonoma County Director of Transportation and Public Works or his designee. The Sonoma County Director of Public Works will review the bids and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors to consider awarding the project within 60 days of bid opening.

The work to be done consists, in general, of construction of pipe headwall and screened inlet and such other items or details, not mentioned above, that are required by the plans, Standard Specifications, or these Special Provisions shall be performed, placed, constructed or installed.

At the time this contract is awarded, the Contractor shall possess a Hazardous Substance Removal Certification and either a Class A license or C-8 Concrete License.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein.

This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code §12990.

Specifications and bid forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the Sonoma County Department of Transportation and Public Works, 2300 County Center Drive, Suite B100, Santa Rosa, California 95403, upon payment of a nonrefundable printing service charge in the following amounts:

Half-size Plans, Specifications & Bid Book	=	\$50.00 (including sales tax)
full size plans (only)	=	\$10.00 (including sales tax)

Checks shall be made payable to the County of Sonoma, and shall be mailed or delivered in person to the Department of Transportation and Public Works.

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambiguity of the plans, specifications or estimate must be communicated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Any such inquiries or questions, submitted after bid opening, will not be treated as a bid protest.

The successful bidder shall furnish both a payment bond and a performance bond for the full amount of the contract.

The County of Sonoma affirms that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation.

Liquidated damages in the amount of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) will be assessed for each and every calendar days delay finishing the work in excess of the allowed working days prescribed in the contract.

Pursuant to Section 1773 and following of the Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of wages in the county, or counties, in which the work is to be done has been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project, available at the California Department of Industrial Relations' Internet web site at <http://www.dir.ca.gov>. Future effective general prevailing wage rates which have been predetermined and are on file with the California Department of Industrial Relations are referenced but not printed in the general prevailing wage rates.
